The holder of this document

- is able to discuss and formulate views on ethical issues and attitudes in the health and social care professions
- is able to administer first aid in emergency situations and carry out heart and lung emergency treatment
- is able to work to promote a good physical and psycho-social working environment
- has a knowledge of Man and the human life cycle from biological, psychological, social and existential aspects affecting people's health
- has a knowledge of common sicknesses and medicines
- has a knowledge of the structure and functions of the human body
- has a knowledge of micro-organisms, their methods of dissemination and hygienic methods of working
- has a knowledge of the social and cultural contexts of importance in the encounter between people in health and care
- the regulations and international agreements applicable in the area of health and care
- has a knowledge of the differences between the conditions of men and women and their living conditions
- has a knowledge of how the working environment affects health
- has a knowledge of information and communications technology
- has an insight into how recycling thinking, as well as how resources and energy can be used efficiently

In addition, the holder of this document has knowledge at the upper secondary school level in Swedish, English, mathematics, arts, sports and health, science studies, religious studies and also civics.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The programme is vocationally specific and provides a broad competence for work in health and the caring professions such as an assistant nurse, psychiatric nurse and personal assistants and also with the care of those with learning disabilities.
